

EMPLOYMENT LAW IN PRACTICE

Changes within businesses often result in labour law consequences in the form of negotiations, the hiring of new employees, transfers and redundancies. For these types of measures to be correctly carried out, it is important that they are solidly supported.

Employment law is a generic term for the legislation governing relations between employers and employees. However, the area includes not only legislation but also regulations, which are established through agreements between employers, employees and labour-market organisations. Employment law contains both rights and obligations of all parties.

The aim of the course is that through practical examples, discussions and exercises improve the ability to solve legal problems within the labour law sphere. The course deals with current legislation and highlights aspects that are important when hiring and dismissing employees, and for participation in decision making, agreements, etc.

This course is for managers and personnel department staff who need insight into and knowledge of the present employment law.
